MFL

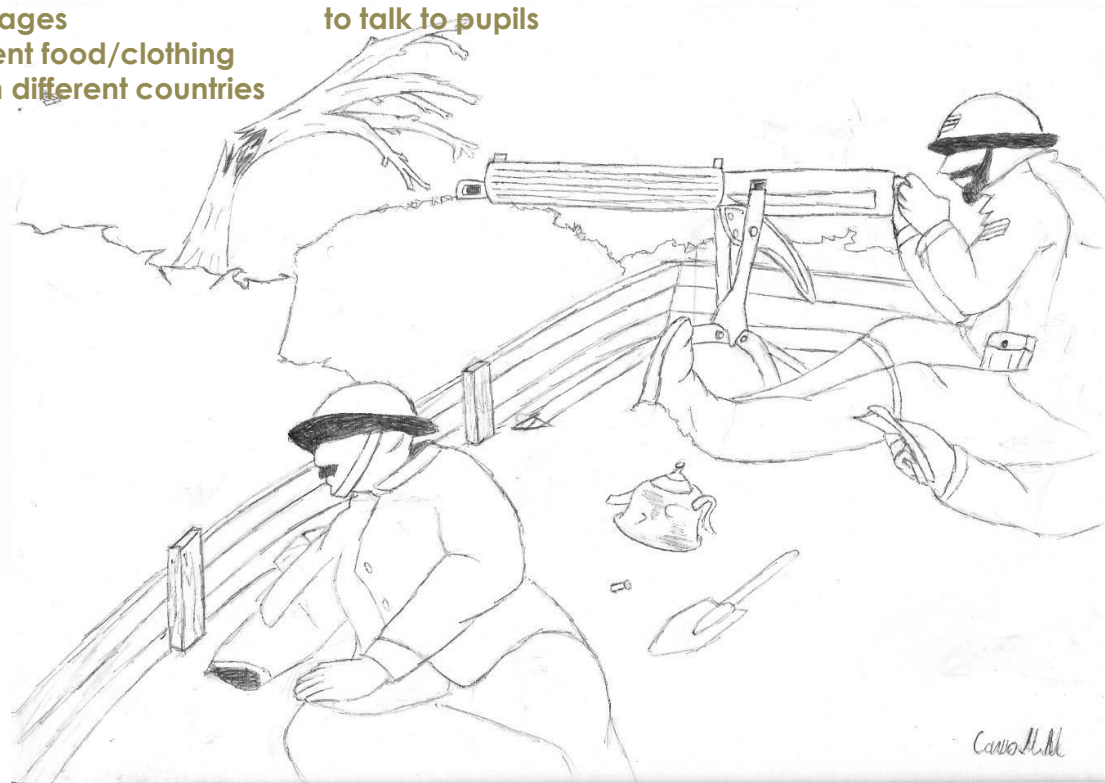
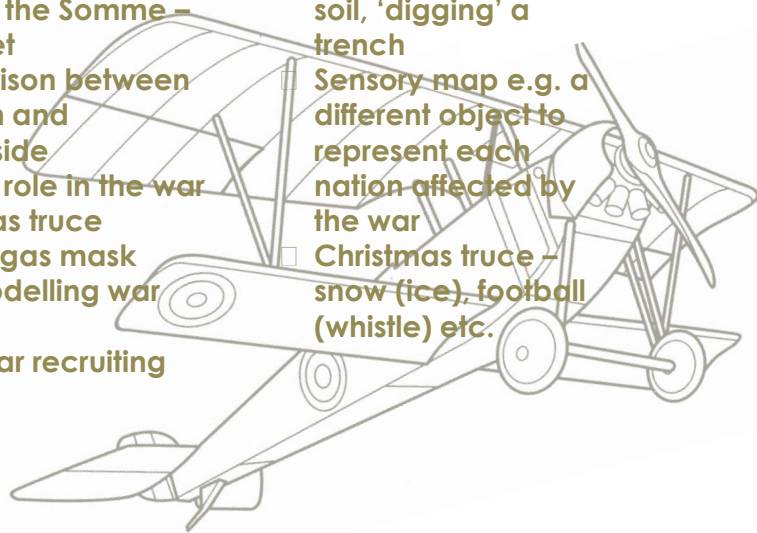
- Nations involved in the war
