



Sensory

- Spring – flowers, seeds, soil, wool (lambs) etc.
- Summer – heat bag, sand (beach), sunglasses, sun cream etc.
- Autumn – harvest vegetables/fruit, bread, leaves, conkers/acorns etc.
- Winter – ice, scarf/gloves, feathers (robin) etc.
- Creating hot/cold/wet/dry environments
- Sensory umbrellas for each season

Music

- Different music to represent each season
- Songs about days of the week/months of the year
- Using instrument to make different weather sounds
- Making different instruments to represent weather sounds
- Resonance boards for weather sounds/songs

Community Visit

- Park/farm/garden centre at different times of the year
- Blenheim palace
- Nature walks
- Arboretum



Science

- Weather in each season
- Clothing for each season
- Seasons in other parts of the world
- Reasons for seasons – Earth/moon
- Creating a calendar – when is each season and what happens
- Plant growth
- Experiments e.g. where does ice melt the quickest?, where does the plant grow the best?
- Animals in different seasons – hibernation, lifecycles
- Observe and find out about puddles/shadows/rainbows

- Building a snowman/sandcastle e.g. using playdough
