



Springfield School Year 7 Catch-Up Premium Report 2018-2019 and Allocation for 2019—2020

Springfield School caters for pupils from 3 – 16 years. Our scrutiny of pupil progress shows that our Year 7 pupils do not experience a reduction in their progress as can be seen with some primary mainstream pupils making the transition to secondary schools. We value the fact that we are on two different sites and believe there is a benefit for our pupils to move 'up' to the secondary site. During the summer term each year, we plan for the Year 6 pupils to visit the secondary site on a number of occasions to become more familiar with the environment, staff and pupils. This definitely aids their transition in September.

Springfield uses the Year 7 Catch-Up Premium to support transition, achievement and participation for our Year 6 and 7 pupils. It has also been used to support Maths resources to ensure pupils can be participating and developing Maths skills across the curriculum.

The Year 7 data shows 90% good or outstanding achievement of EHCP end of year outcomes and all Year 7s are on track to meet their end of Key Stage Outcomes. There was 100% good or outstanding achievement of IEP targets.

The priorities are to have:-

- familiar experienced staff to support transition
- appropriate resources for Communication, Literacy and Maths
- staff skilled in developing Communication, Language and Literacy and Maths.

In 2018 - 2019, the Year 7 Catch-Up Premium allocation was £3,750.
