



Calculation

Pupils will use their knowledge and skills to count and learn number sequences and will be introduced to calculations. Pupils will also develop problem solving skills to help them in everyday situations.

Calculation Key Vocabulary

More/less/add/plus/take away/minus/altogether>equals/sum/total/how many more/difference/double/half/

Calculation activities;

Singing number songs; adding one more or subtracting one less.

Playing boards games; adding on the number of the dice and counting on.

Setting the table; how many knives and forks altogether? How many plates if I get 2 more?

Shopping; adding coins or items together to find a total.

Using soft toys or dolls; how many ears on my 3 teddies?

Card games; find 2 cards that make 10 pelmanism.

Games to make a total score; bowling, skittles, darts, etc

Grouping two sets of objects in a play activity to find a total or taking some away and finding how many are left.

Dominoes; adding the dots to find the total.
